When we set out to design the Next Level Local expansion of NewBo City Market, we knew we needed a partner who didn't just see blueprints but saw potential—for entrepreneurs, for community, for innovation. Enter Andrew Ballard, founder of Studio Combine, an architecture firm that, much like the Market itself, is built on the belief that creativity and entrepreneurship are the engines of progress.

We were intentional about choosing an early-stage firm, not just because we love supporting entrepreneurs, but because Andrew's approach to design is exactly what NewBo stands for—bold ideas, deep community roots, and a relentless commitment to getting things done. Though Studio Combine was founded in 2020, Andrew is no newcomer. With an Artium Baccalaureus in Architecture from Princeton and a Master of Architecture from UC Berkeley, plus years at Jensen Architects and Neumann Monson Architects, his portfolio spans high-end residences, performance venues, food spaces, and campus master plans from coast to coast and beyond.

But what sets Andrew apart isn't just his résumé—it's his spirit. Every meeting, he brings a mix of lighthearted humor and laser-sharp problem-solving that makes collaboration a joy. He listens. He adapts. He dreams big with us. He understands that NewBo isn't just a building—it's a living, breathing hub of creativity and opportunity. His ability to translate that energy into design is why our expansion isn't just functional—it's inspired.

With Studio Combine at the helm, the Next Level Local expansion will be more than additional square footage. It will be a space where small businesses thrive, where community gathers year-round, and where the next generation of entrepreneurs finds their footing.

At NewBo, we believe entrepreneurs shape the future—and Andrew Ballard is proof. We're honored to have him as a partner in bringing this vision to life.

# **NEXT LEVEL LOCAL**

NewBo City Market was originally envisioned by community leaders in Cedar Rapids as a way to revitalize a community devastated by disaster after the 2008 flood. With a large green space, a stage, an educational community kitchen, and a large indoor event space, NewBo City Market has helped to foster the community vitality and recreation that was necessary to economically develop an entire neighborhood.

The Market plans and executes over 300 community events each year and incubates nearly 300 small businesses through providing business mentorship and physical space. Each year over 500,000 people visit the Market to shop, eat, and enjoy free programming and educational classes. The Market has become a centerpiece to Cedar Rapids, the second largest city in lowa, in its ten year existence. As we look ahead to the next ten years, we choose to respond—as we always have—to the greatest needs of our community. This has prompted us to design the Next Level Local Capital Campaign—a targeted expansion that will increase our business incubation, local food access, and public events capacity.

Introduce a new indoor stage to host year-round events and gatherings.

### **CULTIVATE**

Launch a local foods grocery store to support the community.




